

Notes regarding the operating manual

Symbols



Warning of electrical voltage

This symbol indicates dangers to the life and health of persons due to electrical voltage.



Warning

This signal word indicates a hazard with an average risk level which, if not avoided, can result in serious injury or death.



Caution

This signal word indicates a hazard with a low risk level which, if not avoided, can result in minor or moderate injury.

Note

Safety

Read this manual carefully before starting or using the device. Always store the manual in the immediate vicinity of the device or its site of use!



Warning

Read all safety warnings and all instructions.

Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and / or serious injury. Save all warnings and instructions for future reference.

This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

- Do not use the device in potentially explosive rooms.
- Do not use the device in aggressive atmosphere.
- Set the device up in an upright and stable position.
- Let the device dry out after a wet clean. Do not operate it when wet.
- Do not use the device with wet or damp hands.
- Do not expose the device to directly squirting water.
- Never insert any objects or limbs into the device.
- Do not cover or transport the device during operation.
- Do not sit on the device.
- This appliance is not a toy! Keep away from children and animals. Do not leave the device unattended during operation.
- Check accessories and connection parts for possible damage prior to every use of the device. Do not use any defective devices or device parts.



- Ensure that all electric cables outside of the device are protected from damage (e.g. caused by animals). Never use the device if electric cables or the power connection are damaged!
- The electrical connection must correspond to the specifications in chapter Technical data.
- Insert the mains plug into a properly secured mains socket
- Observe the technical data when selecting extensions to the power cable. Completely unroll the extension cable.
 Avoid electrical overload.
- Before carrying out maintenance, care or repair work on the device, remove the mains plug from the mains socket.
 Hold onto the mains plug while doing so.
- Switch the device off and disconnect the power cable from the mains socket when the device is not in use.
- Do not under any circumstances use the device if you detect damages on the mains plug or power cable.
 If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
 - Defective power cables pose a serious health risk!
- When positioning the device, observe the minimum distances from walls and other objects as well as the storage and operating conditions specified in the Technical data chapter.
- Make sure that the air inlet and outlet are not obstructed.
- Make sure that there are no loose items or dirt located in the immediate surroundings of air inlet and air outlet.
- When unmounted, the device should be neither operated nor connected to the mains.
- Improper installation can lead to a fire, electric shock or severe personal injury.
- The device is provided with an overheating protection which is activated by overheating of the device (when exceeding the operating temperature). In such an event the device switches off automatically.

Intended use

Only use the device TVE 23 S as pedestal fan for the ventilation of interior spaces whilst adhering to the technical data.

Improper use

- Do not place the device on wet or flooded ground.
- Do not place any objects, e.g. clothing, on the device.
- Do not use the device outdoors.
- Any operation other than as described in this manual is prohibited. Non-observance renders all claims for liability and guarantee null and void.
- Any unauthorised modifications, alterations or structural changes to the device are forbidden.

Personnel qualifications

People who use this device must:

- be aware of the dangers that occur when working with electric devices in damp areas.
- have read and understood the operating manual, especially the Safety chapter.

Residual risks



Warning of electrical voltage

Work on the electrical components must only be carried out by an authorised specialist company!



Warning of electrical voltage

Before any work on the device, remove the mains plug from the mains socket!

Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.



Warning

Dangers can occur at the device when it is used by untrained people in an unprofessional or improper way! Observe the personnel qualifications!

The device is not a toy and does not belong in the hands of children.



Warning

Behaviour in the event of an emergency

- 1. Switch off the device.
- 2. In an emergency, disconnect the device from the mains feed-in: Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.
- 3. Do not reconnect a defective device to the mains.


Device description


The pedestal fans of the TVE S series are suitable for indoor air circulation.

The device TVE 23 S comes with the following features:

- 3 speed levels
- Height adjustability
- Inclination angle of the fan head vertically adjustable by up to 30°
- On-demand 80° oscillation

Transport and storage

Note

If you store or transport the device improperly, the device may be damaged.

Note the information regarding transport and storage of the device.

Transport

Before transporting the device, observe the following:

- Switch off the device.
- Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.
- Do not use the power cable to drag the device.

After transporting the device, observe the following:

• Set up the device in an upright position after transport.

Storage

Before storing the device, proceed as follows:

- Switch off the device.
- Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.

When the device is not being used, observe the following storage conditions:

- dry and protected from frost and heat
- in an upright position where it is protected from dust and direct sunlight
- with a cover to protect it from invasive dust, if necessary
- Place no further devices or objects on top of the device to prevent it from being damaged.



Assembly and start-up

Scope of delivery

- 1 x Device TVE 23 S
- 1 x Manual
- Connection screw


Unpacking the device

- 1. Open the cardboard box and take the device out.
- 2. Completely remove the packaging.
- Fully unwind the power cable. Make sure that the power cable is not damaged and that you do not damage it during unwinding.

Assembly


Mounting the foot

- 1. Connect the foot (3) to the lower part of the pole.
- 2. Tighten the two parts below the foot using the supplied connection screw (10).




Connecting the operating element and pole

- 1. Connect the upper part of the pole to the lower part, and fix both parts using the locking screw for the rods (4).
- 2. Connect the operating element (6) to the upper part of the pole, and fix both parts using the locking screw for the operating element (5).



Mounting the rotor


- 1. Fit the rear part of the protective grid (12) on the motor spindle (11).
- 2. Fasten both elements with the retaining ring (13).






Fastening the impeller on the motor spindle

- 1. Fit the impeller (14) on the motor spindle (11).
- 2. Fasten the impeller (14) using the impeller retaining cap (15).



Mounting and closing the protective grid


- 1. Fit the front part of the protective grid (16) on the rear part of the protective grid.
- 2. Make sure that the two parts are fixed by all fastening clips (17).
- 3. Use the fastening screw (18) at the bottom of the protective grid to fasten the two grid parts.



Setting the fan's inclination angle

The inclination angle of the fan can be manually adjusted by up to 30° .


- Move the fan head forward or back so that it is slightly inclined either to the front or to the rear. Make sure that the fan head locks into place at the desired inclination angle.
 - ⇒ The fan's inclination angle has been set and the air will flow out at the selected inclination angle.






Adjusting the height

The fan height can be adjusted to 2 positions. Remove the lower rod element to adjust the fan height from 130 cm to 96 cm.



Start-up

When positioning the device, observe the minimum distance from walls or other objects as described in the Technical data chapter.

Warning

Risk of injury due to incorrect start-up!
There is a risk of injury if the protective grid is not installed correctly around the impeller. The protective grid must be installed correctly before the device is switched on.



Warning

Risk of injury if protective grid is removed! There is a risk of injury if the protective grid is removed during operation. Do not remove the protective grid while the device is in operation!

- Before restarting the device, check the condition of the power cable. If there are doubts as to the sound condition, contact the customer service.
- Set the device up in an upright and stable position.
- Do not create tripping hazards when laying the power cable or other electric cables, especially when positioning the device in the middle of the room. Use cable bridges.
- Make sure that extension cables are completely unrolled.
- Make sure that no curtains or other objects interfere with the air flow.


Connecting the power cable

 Insert the mains plug into a properly secured mains socket.



Operation

Operating element



No.	Designation	Meaning
19	Control dial	Switches the fan on or off:
		Stage 0 = off
		Stage 1 = low
		Stage 2 = medium
		Stage 3 = high

Switching the device on

Note

The control dial (19) can be rotated 360° both clockwise and counter-clockwise.

Once you have completely installed the device as described in the Start-up chapter, you can switch it on.

- 1. Turn the control dial (19) to the desired stage.
 - ⇒ The device starts at the selected fan stage.

Setting the fan stage


The fan can be set to three stages while in operation.

- 1. Turn the control dial (19) to the desired stage to activate it.
 - ⇒ The fan operates at the selected fan stage.


Using the oscillation function

By means of the oscillation function you can achieve consistent ventilation.

- ✓ The device is switched on and operating.
- 1. Press the oscillation pin (7) so that it locks in place.



- ⇒ The oscillation function is activated.
- ⇒ The fan head rotates to and fro by up to 80°.



- 1. Press the oscillation pin (7) again to switch the oscillation function back off.
 - ⇒ The oscillation function is deactivated.
 - ⇒ The device stops oscillation at the desired position and continues to run in the selected operating mode.



Shutdown



Warning of electrical voltage

Do not touch the mains plug with wet or damp hands.

- Switch off the device.
- Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.
- Clean the device according to the Maintenance chapter.
- Store the device according to the Storage chapter.

Errors and faults

The device has been checked for proper functioning several times during production. If malfunctions occur nonetheless, check the device according to the following list.

The device does not start:

- Check the power connection.
- Check the power cable and mains plug for damages.
- Check the on-site fusing.
- Check whether the overheating protection has tripped, see chapter Safety.
- Wait for 10 minutes before restarting the device. If the device is not starting, have the electrics checked by a specialist company or by Trotec.

The fan does not start:

- Check whether the unit is switched on.
- Check the power supply and whether the plug or cable is defective.

The device is loud or vibrates:

- Check whether the device is set up in a stable and upright position.
- Check whether the device is mounted correctly.

Your device still does not operate correctly after these checks?

Please contact the customer service. If necessary, bring the device to an authorized specialist electrical company or to Trotec for repair.

Maintenance

Activities required before starting maintenance



Warning of electrical voltage

Do not touch the mains plug with wet or damp hands.


- Switch the device off.
- Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.

Cleaning the housing

Clean the housing with a soft, damp and lint-free cloth. Make sure that no moisture enters the housing. Protect electrical components from moisture. Do not use any aggressive cleaning agents such as cleaning sprays, solvents, alcohol-based or abrasive cleaners to dampen the cloth.

Cleaning the fan blades

- ✓ The device is switched off.
- ✓ The power cable has been removed from the mains socket.
- 1. Remove the protective grid according to the instructions in the chapter Assembly and start-up.
- 2. Clean the fan blades with a soft, damp and lint-free cloth. Ensure that no moisture enters the housing. Protect electrical components from moisture. Do not use any aggressive cleaning agents such as cleaning sprays, solvents, alcohol-based or abrasive cleaners to dampen the cloth.



• Other than that, the device does not require maintenance.
